Cartagena's gastronomy is a mixture of intense flavors that are grown on their lands and produce indescribable sensations when combined with some birds, red meats and products from the swamp, rivers and sea. Every bite is a party on the palate! Cartagena cuisine has a popular origin, which is based on fried foods, rice, soups and stews; but it is also a cuisine that adopts elements from other areas of the world, such as meats cooked over low heat, with vegetables, and based on delicious, shiny sauces and strong flavors. One of the traditions of Cartagena cuisine is known as arroz con carne en tabaquito: small pieces of salted and stewed meat that, when mixed with rice, create a very pleasant dish, with deep textures and aromas.

You can also find meat empanadas and the famous egg arepa; Soups such as sancocho and mote de queso, which contains yam, are some delicacies that can be tried in Cartagena and its surroundings.

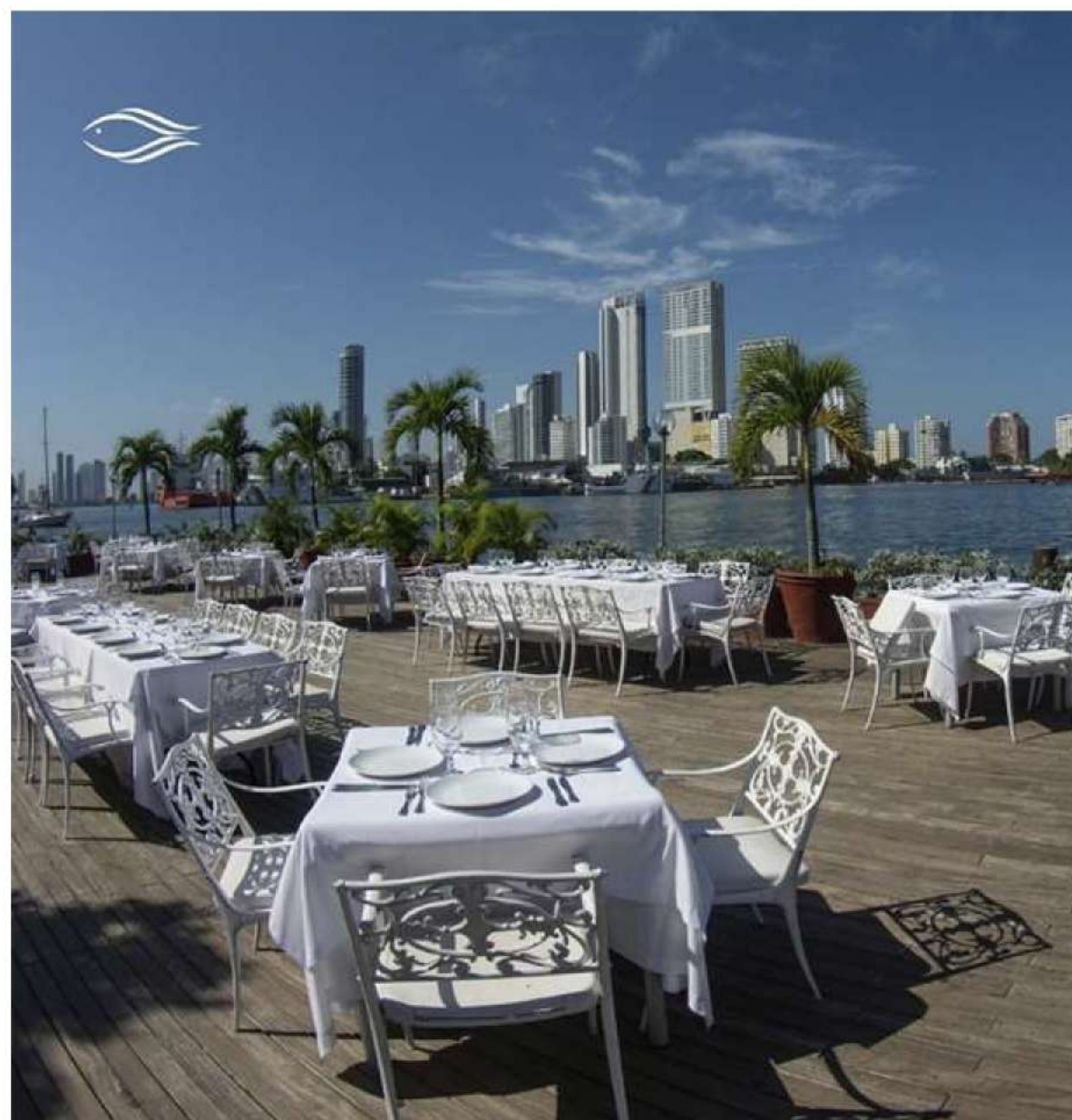

COLETTE BISTRO

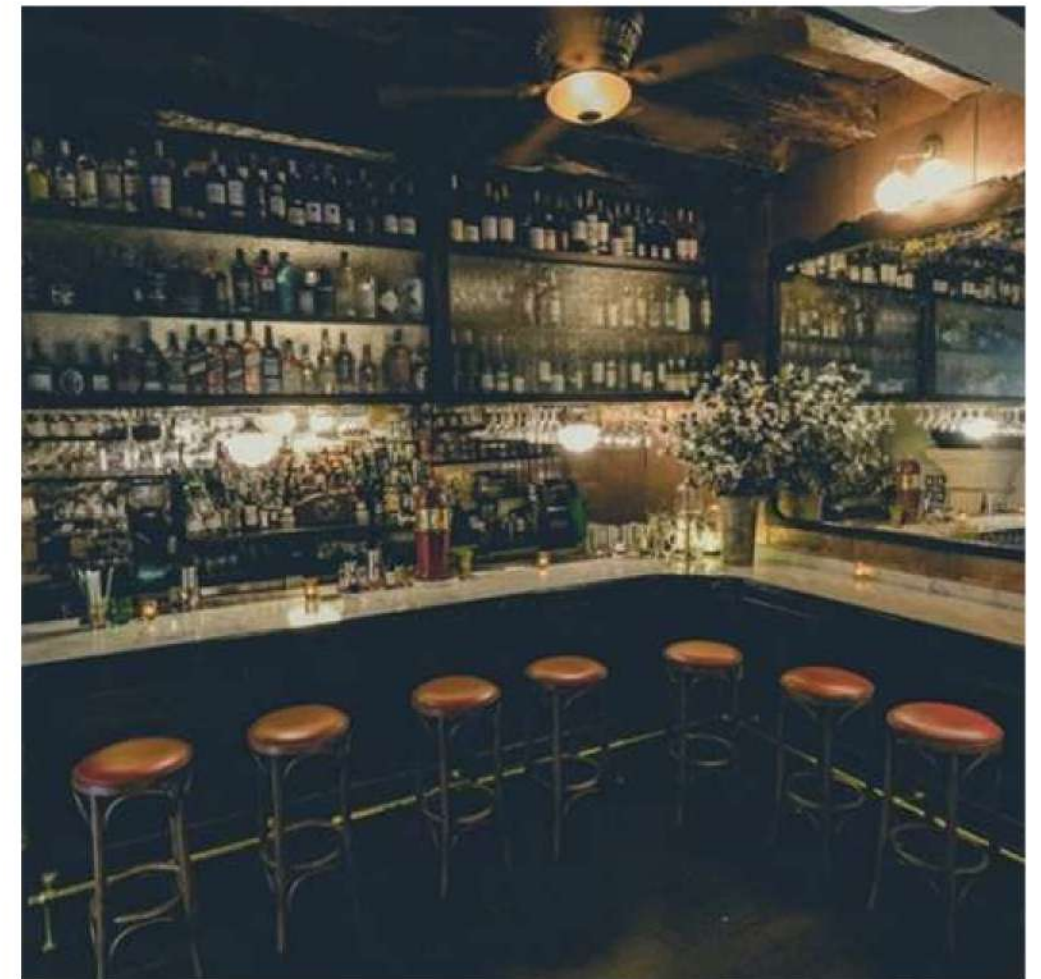
